LAGUNA BEACH COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT FUNDS SUPPORT THE MY HERO MEDIA ARTS MENTORING PROGRAM, WHICH OFFERED TO THURSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL, LAGUNA BEACH HIGH SCHOOL, ANNELESE'S SCHOOL, THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB AND LOCAL NON-PROFITS. GRANT FUNDS WERE USED TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PROGRAM INCLUDING A COMPUTER, MICROPHONE AND A CAMERA.
